

RULES OF COMPETITION AND PLAY AT LILLESHALL HALL GOLF CLUB

- All Golf will be played strictly to the Rules of Golf 2012 – 2015, as approved by the R&A and the U.S.G.A.
 - Local Rules are printed on the Scorecard and additional Permanent and Temporary Rules will be displayed on the appropriate notice board.
Please familiarise yourself with these, as well as the Rules of Golf, as ignorance of the Rules is no defence in the case of infringement.
 - Medal and Stableford Competitions will be played as two and three balls only. Two balls *must* allow single competitors to join them.
 - It is a REGULATION OF COMPETITION that scores are entered on the computer.
 - In Mixed Foursome Competitions, Male Competitors will tee off on the *odd* holes, it follows that Lady Competitors will tee off on the *even* holes.
 - A player shall walk at all times during a competition round. (Unless permission to the contrary is granted by The Committee)
 - **COMPETITORS HAVE PRIORITY AT ALL TIMES.**
 - The Playing Format of the day has priority e.g. If there is a Fourball Alliance Competition on, it will not be necessary to automatically call two balls through as normal under etiquette. (Except lost ball etc.) On Medal and Stableford days, Competitors have priority over Fourballs.
 - By local rule, single players have no standing on the course.
 - It is requested that Competitors avoid playing Club Knockout Matches on Competition days, unless the Match format is similar to the Competition format. e.g. *it would be acceptable to play a PGA Match on a Fourball day.*
 - When starting times are in operation, they must be strictly adhered to. Players starting before 8.00a.m. must start on the front nine, or the back nine, to ensure that their playing numbers are in the correct position on the course after 8.00 a.m.
 - General Play for Men will be from the Yellow Tees. Competition Rounds only will be played from the White Tees.
 - Practicing on the course is not allowed (e.g. playing two balls)
 - Please familiarise, or re-familiarise yourself with the Etiquette section of the Rules of Golf, and apply them for the good of all competitors.
 - Please play without delay, if it is your “Honour” tee off and then mark the scorecard. Avoid moving around in “packs”, move to your ball and be ready to play when it is your turn. Pick up if your score is meaningless. Line up your putt when others are putting. Leave your bag on the “next tee side” of the Green.
 - **Scores and cards must be returned as soon as reasonably practical after completion of the round.**
